I sat on the table with Ziad between my legs wrapped around him and my hands holding his head. Gaby was also holding him too and the doctor tried one more time. I was praying the whole time she could get it out. Then all of a sudden it flung out and landed on my arm!! Ziad had screamed so much his face was swollen and the next day he was sent home from school.
