I am so saddened to write that Caris our precious princess went home to be with Jesus March 20. I am heartbroken and sad but at the same time rejoicing that she is no longer in pain and is running in heaven. We were told she would live only a year. She was almost 16 years old when she died. We in the Casa Cuna and so many others were blessed to know and love her.



At the end of February we had a team from Michigan here. Most of the team worked on the wall behind the Casa Cuna. Last fall the wall collapsed during a storm and the Casa Cuna and the Casa Matriz had flooding. We are thankful for the brick wall being put back up. Also many of the children and workers were blessed to get their hair cut and other small jobs were done as well.



After the team left some of the men and older boys from the Casa Hogar continued to work on the wall. It is not complete but they have gotten a lot done.



Before being quarantine my family had a chance to spend a day at the beach when Belen and Cristian were with us for the weekend. It was nice to have a fun day together.



The Casa Hogar has been staying in each of our buildings for a few weeks now. With the children not being in school the teachers have been sending through videos lots of school work for them. It has been keeping our days very busy. I have been doing the English school work with the children and Danny. We have been trying to think of different things to do to break up the day. The children have enjoyed the activities.



Kenia has been helping me with the Sunday school class for the Casa Cuna. Last week we did Noah's ark and had animal face mask for the children to wear. They were so excited. After lunch that day Eva asked if we could have Bible school tomorrow too. 😊

I am so thankful for your support and prayers. They both are a huge blessing to my ministry work here in Colima.
