

DRIVE-IN SERVICE EXPECTATIONS

Following these expectations allows church to stay open and keeps people safer



PARKING

All cars need to come in off of **28th Ave** near the church and follow the parking attendants' directions. The Rosewood St. entrance will be closed.

In-car option for service: Turn on your **hazard flashers** to help parking attendants direct you to your designated spot.

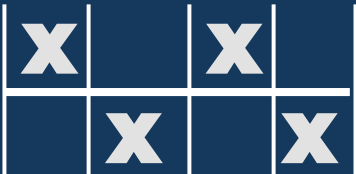


SOCIAL

DISTANCING

Please keep **6 ft distance at all times**. This includes walking to and from your car, staying in your designated spots during the service, and during fellowship afterwards. Please keep your kids with you at all times.

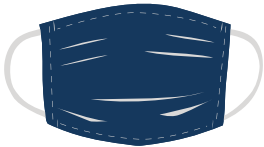
By observing social distancing we all help to keep everyone safer.



SEATING

Each household will be sitting in a separated **parking spot**. Spaces on either side and in front or back will be empty to help maintain proper distance. If you need help, let a usher know and they can help you find a seat.

Bring chairs, water, sunscreen and perhaps a blanket for kids to sit on.



MASKS REQUIRED

Masks are a way to protect others around you from transmission. We see this as an opportunity to protect our fellow congregants while worshipping. Masks are **required** for everyone attending our services outdoors, including **before, during, and after** the service. Masks are available if you need one. If you prefer not to or unable to wear a mask we ask you choose to stay in your car or join us online with our livestream through our Rosewood Church public Facebook page.



SINGING

When singing, please face forward (towards the stage) and keep out of the walkways. Singing presents a higher risk of transmission, so we want to avoid singing in close proximity to others or in the direction of others. By adhering to these expectations we keep everyone safer.



DESIGNATED
AREAS

Please do not approach the designated areas by the **technology booth** and on/around the **stage**. These areas will be for specific **volunteers only**. Please stay clear of these areas before, during, and after services, as only trained volunteers are permitted to touch the equipment.



BATHROOM

Bathrooms will be available through the front entrance in the narthex. Only **one household** will be allowed in the church at a time. Masks must be worn at all times while in the building.



RAIN PLAN

In the event of rain we will move **online** to a livestreamed version at **9:30 AM**. You will be notified via email and social media (or by call for those without email) if the in person service is cancelled. You will be able to watch through our Rosewood Church public Facebook page (no Facebook account needed).
